Airport Safe Practices and COVID-19 Operation Changes

As the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation rapidly evolves, Bay City Regional Airport continues to act to help protect the health and welfare of the community.

- Passengers traveling from certain states and cities are subject to a questionnaire and are required to self-quarantine for 14 days in accordance with Executive Order Number GA11. (see staff or posted flyers for information on affected states and cities.)
- Bay City Regional Airport continues to be open from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Call out services are available from 5 p.m.-8 a.m.
- Jet A is available both by Truck and self-service. Avgas is available via self-service only, except when necessary as determined on a case by case basis.
- Access to the Bay City Regional Airport terminal is open. However, there are restrictions that will be followed.
 1. The total number of persons allowed in the terminal at one time is 9. This includes staff.
 2. Social distancing, maintaining at least 6' between you and another person, must be followed at all time.
- Bay City Regional Airport staff is not permitted to handle passengers' or flight crews' luggage or personal effects.
- Passengers vehicles will be escorted to/from aircraft on the ramp.
- Crew cars are not available.
- Additional cleaning and sanitization of all work and common spaces.
- Administrative offices are closed to the public. Customers are encouraged to conduct as much business as possible over the phone and via email.
